**ORDER APPROVING TARIFF SHEET
TO CHANGE COST ADJUSTMENT FACTOR OF
FUEL ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE**

Effective Date: March 1, 2012

On December 22, 2011, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company filed a revised tariff sheet intended to reflect changes to its Fuel Adjustment Clause. The company has two separate rate districts; MPS and L&P. The proposed changes will result in a decrease of \$0.61 per month for typical residential customers in the MPS district and an increase of approximately \$3.29 for residential customers in the L&P district.

On January 23, the Staff of the Commission filed its recommendation to approve the proposed tariff. Staff explains that the increase for those in the L&P district is due to increased use of short-term purchased power after the expiration of a Nebraska Public Power District contract on May 31, 2011, and coal conservation at the Iatan and Lake Road generating stations after the Missouri River flooding during Accumulation Period 8. The Commission has reviewed Staff's Recommendation and will approve the proposed tariff sheet

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The following tariff sheet, Tariff No. JE-2012-0296, is approved to become effective on March 1, 2012:
