## ORDER RESOLVING FIFTH TRUE-UP FILING

Issue Date: May 1, 2012 Effective Date: May 22, 2012

On March 23, 2012, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed direct testimony and schedules in support of its fifth true-up filing as required by Commission rules 4 CSR 240-3.161 and 20.090. Commission rule 4 CSR 240-20.090(5)(D) requires the Commission's Staff to analyze the information Ameren has submitted and to submit a recommendation to the Commission not later than 30 days after Ameren's filing. Also under the rule, the Commission must within 60 days approve, reject, or suspend Ameren's true-up filing.

In its recommendation filed on April 23, 2012, Staff states that the true-up amount for Recovery Period 5 (billing months February 2011 through January 2012) is an undercollection by Ameren of \$4,725,389 plus interest. Staff therefore recommends that the Commission approve Ameren's fifth true-up filing for inclusion in the company's 9<sup>th</sup> recovery period fuel and purchased power adjustment rates for the billing months of June 2012 through January 2013. Ameren has filed, in File No. ER-2012-0319, a tariff reflecting this calculation.

Based on the calculations set out in Staff's Memorandum in File No. ER-2012-0319, the Fuel Adjustment Charge of a residential customer consuming 1,100kWh per month will increase by approximately \$1.43 per month. Based on the verified recommendation of its Staff, the Commission will approve Ameren's request.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The true-up amount for Recovery Period 5 is established as an under-collection by Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri of \$4,725,389 plus interest, to be included in its FPA rate adjustment filing.
  - 2. This order shall become effective on May 22, 2012.
