ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, SETTING INTERVENTION DEADLINE AND DIRECTING STAFF RECOMMENDATION

On July 2, 2012, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (“GMO”) submitted an application containing its annual true-up concerning its Fuel Adjustment Clause (“FAC”). GMO requests that the Commission approve the over collection amounts as calculated by GMO and authorize GMO to include those amounts in its next accumulation period.

Pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.090(5), the Commission’s Staff shall submit a recommendation regarding the proposed true-up no later than 30 days after it’s filing. No later than 60 days after receiving the proposed true-up, the Commission must: (1) issue an order deciding the true-up; or (2) suspend the timeline of the true-up to receive additional evidence or hold a hearing if required. Consequently, the Commission shall issue notice, set an intervention deadline, and direct its Staff to file a recommendation.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.161(10) provides that parties to the rate case in which the Commission established GMO’s fuel adjustment clause are automatically parties to this tariff case, without the necessity of having to apply for intervention. The Commission therefore acknowledges that the parties to File No. ER-2007-0004 are parties to this case, and will direct its Data Center to add those parties to the service list. The Data Center will also be directed to send notice of this order to the parties in File No. ER-2012-0197, where

the Commission approved GMO's semi-annual FAC rate schedules and File No. ER-2012-0175, GMO's current rate case.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall serve a copy of this order upon the parties to file numbers listed in the body of this order.

2. The Commission's Data Center shall add all parties to File No. ER-2007-0004 to the service list for this case.

3. Any person or entity wishing to intervene shall file an application to intervene no later than July 12, 2012, with:

4. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall, no later than August 1, 2012, file a recommendation regarding its examination and analysis of KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company's application.
