On December 22, 2014, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri") applied to the Commission for approval of certain demand-side programs, a Technical Resource Manual (TRM), and a Demand-Side Investment Mechanism (DSIM) as contemplated by the Missouri Energy Efficiency Investment Act (MEEIA) and the Commission's implementing regulations.
