

5. On April 16, 2015, the Commission issued its Order Directing Notice And Setting Filing Date, directing the Staff to file a report of its review of the Company's Compliance Report before May 29, 2015, forty-five (45) days from the Company's filing.

6. In its *Memorandum*, attached hereto and labeled as Attachment A, Staff reports on its review of the Company's Annual RES Compliance Report.

7. Upon examination, Staff discovered that the Company has not met the minimum requirements for compliance in 2014 by failing to meet the statutory S-REC retirement requirements. Staff is currently working with Ameren to determine the number of S-RECs needed for full compliance. Therefore, Staff recommends the Company obtain a waiver to retire S-RECs for 2014 compliance outside of the statutorily designated time frame.

8. The Staff is unaware of any other case currently pending before the Commission that a decision in this file will directly affect, or be affected by.

WHEREFORE, the Staff submits this *Staff Report* for the Commission's information and consideration.
