**ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE AND
ORDER DIRECTING RESPONSES TO APPLICATION**

On February 1, 2016, Gerald Fuemmeler filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission requesting that his electric supplier be changed from Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCP&L") to The City of Salisbury ("Salisbury").¹

The Commission will direct its Data Center to send notice of the application to KCP&L, GMO, and Salisbury. Because they are necessary parties, KCP&L, GMO and Salisbury will be joined to this proceeding and will be directed to file responses to the application. Finally, the Commission will direct the Staff of the Commission to file a recommendation.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Data Center of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall send this order, with a copy of the application, to Kansas City Power & Light Company, to KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company, and The City of Salisbury, Missouri.

¹ Because the Commission is concerned that the actual current supplier is KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("GMO"), and not KCP&L, the Commission will direct notice to both companies.

2. Kansas City Power & Light Company and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company are made parties to this proceeding and shall file a response to the application no later than March 2, 2016.

3. The City of Salisbury, Missouri is made a party to this proceeding and shall file a response to the application no later than March 2, 2016.

4. The Staff of the Commission shall file its recommendation no later than March 16, 2016.

5. This order shall be effective when issued.
