ORDER REGARDING 2016 INTEGRATED RESOURCE PLAN

Issue Date: April 6, 2017 Effective Date: May 6, 2017

The Empire District Electric Company ("Empire") filed its 2016 Integrated Resource Plan ("IRP"), as required by the Commission's Electric Utility Resource Planning Rule, 4 CSR 240-22. Dogwood Energy LLC, Renew Missouri, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, and the Missouri Department of Economic Development - Division of Energy submitted comments on Empire's IRP filing. As provided for by rule, the parties filed a Joint Filing that addressed sixteen agreed-to remedies for various alleged deficiencies and concerns expressed by some of the parties. The Joint Filing also identified nine alleged deficiencies and concerns that remained unresolved. Empire submitted comments concerning the unresolved issues.

The Commission's rules establish the procedures for the IRP process. Since there are no requirements for a hearing on IRP filings, this is considered a non-contested case. Therefore, the Commission may resolve this matter informally and at its discretion. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-22.080(16) states that:

The Commission will issue an order which contains its findings regarding at least one (1) of the following options:

- (A) That the electric utility's filing pursuant to this rule either does or does not demonstrate compliance with the requirement of this chapter, and that the utility's resource acquisition strategy either does or does not meet the requirements stated in 4 CSR 240-22.
- (B) That the commission approves or disapproves the joint filing on the remedies to the plan deficiencies or concerns developed pursuant to section (9) of this rule;
- (C) That the commission understands that full agreement on remedying deficiencies or concerns is not reached and pursuant to section (10) of this rule, the commission will issue an order which indicates on what items, if any, a hearing(s) will be held and which establishes a procedural schedule; and
- (D) That the commission establishes a procedural schedule for filings and a hearing(s), if necessary, to remedy deficiencies or concerns as specified by the commission.

After considering the comments of the parties and the Joint Filing, the Commission finds that pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-22.080(16)(A), Empire's IRP filing is in substantial compliance with the requirements of Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-22.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-22.080(16)(A), the Commission finds The Empire District Electric Company's 2016 Triennial Compliance Filing is in substantial compliance with the requirements of Chapter 22 and the utility's resource acquisition strategy does meet the requirements stated in 4 CSR 240-22.
 - 2. This order shall become effective on May 6, 2017.

3. This file shall close on May 7, 2017.
