**ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, SETTING INTERVENTION DEADLINE  
AND DIRECTING STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

On December 3, 2020, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri submitted direct testimony and a tariff designed to implement a true-up and adjustment under its Fuel and Purchased Power Adjustment Clause (FAC). Ameren Missouri requests that the Commission authorize a true-up adjustment and implement it under its FAC tariff. The proposed tariff has an effective date of February 1, 2021.

Pursuant to Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-20.090(8)(F), the Commission's Staff shall submit a recommendation regarding the proposed adjustments no later than thirty days after Ameren Missouri's filing. Pursuant to 20.090(8)(H), within sixty days after receiving the proposed adjustment, the Commission must: (1) issue an interim rate adjustment; (2) allow the tariff sheets and adjustments to take effect without a Commission order; or (3) suspend the timeline to receive additional evidence or hold a hearing, if required. Consequently, the Commission shall issue notice, set an intervention deadline, and direct its Staff to file a recommendation.

Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-20.090(17)(A) provides that parties to the rate case in which the Commission established Ameren Missouri's fuel adjustment clause are automatically parties to this tariff case, without the necessity of having to apply for intervention. Therefore, the Commission acknowledges that the parties to File No. ER-2019-0335 (the file in which Ameren Missouri's FAC was most recently re-approved) are parties to these cases, and will direct its Data Center to add those parties to the service lists.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Commission's Data Center shall serve a copy of this order upon the parties to File No. ER-2019-0335.

2. The Commission's Data Center shall add all parties to File No. ER-2019-0335 to the service lists for these cases.

3. Any person or entity wishing to intervene shall file an application to intervene no later than December 23, 2020.

4. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file a recommendation regarding its examination and analysis of Ameren Missouri's tariff filing no later than December 31, 2020.

5. Any responses to Staff's recommendation or comments on Ameren Missouri's tariff filing are due no later than January 12, 2021.

6. The Commission's Data Center shall serve a copy of this order upon the county commission of each county in the service territory of Ameren Missouri.

7. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make notice of this order available to the members of the Missouri General Assembly representing the residents of the service area of Ameren Missouri and to the news media serving the residents of the service territory of Ameren Missouri.

8. This order is effective when issued.
