**STAFF RESPONSE TO COMMISSION’S JUNE 10, 2009
ORDERS TO JOINT MOTION TO EXTEND FILING DATE**

Comes now the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) in response to the Commission’s June 10, 2009 Orders To Joint Motion To Extend Filing Date in Case Nos. ER-2009-0089, ER-2009-0090, and HR-2009-0092 and files a preliminary report regarding its construction audit and prudence review of the Iatan 1 environmental upgrades.

The Staff is filing the entirety of its preliminary report under the Highly Confidential designation since the Staff believes that there may be considerable portions of the preliminary report that Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCPL) and/or KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company’s (GMO) may want designated as Highly Confidential. There are two

attachments to the Staff's preliminary report the entire contents of which KCPL has designated as Highly Confidential.

It is the Staff's hope that once KCPL and GMO have had an opportunity to review the Staff's preliminary report, they will be able to indicate what portions may be filed as an open "public" document. The Staff is aware that certain portions of the preliminary report are not Highly Confidential, but those portions are generally limited to matters such as a discussion of "prudence" and "burden of proof" which are matters of general public interest, i.e., matters not specific to Iatan 1 costs or Iatan common plant / common costs.

Wherefore the Staff hereby files a preliminary report regarding its construction audit and prudence review of the Iatan 1 environmental upgrades.
