On January 17, 2007, Weber Gas Energy, LLC filed an application for a certificate of convenience and necessity to construct and operate a natural gas distribution system in portions of St. Louis County, Missouri.

Proper parties should be given notice and an opportunity to intervene in this matter. The Data Center of the Commission shall send a copy of this order to the County Commission of St. Louis County. The Information Office of the Commission shall send notice of this application to the members of the General Assembly who represent St. Louis County, and to the newspapers that serve St. Louis County, as listed in the newspaper directory of the current *Official Manual of the State of Missouri*. Anyone wishing to intervene must submit an application to intervene as ordered herein.

This order will also require that the Staff of the Commission file its memorandum, recommending whether the Commission should approve or reject the application.
