#### **ANSWER**

COMES NOW Respondent Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCPL"), by and through its attorneys, and makes the following response to the complaint filed in this matter:

- 1. KCPL lacks knowledge or sufficient information regarding Maurice Banks' residence and therefore leaves Maurice Banks to his proof.
- 2. KCPL admits that it is a public utility under the jurisdiction of the Public Service Commission of the State of Missouri.
- 3. With respect to paragraph two, KCPL admits that KCPL denied Maurice Banks' request for electric service at a commercial property. KCPL admits that Maurice Banks provided KCPL with identification, and a copy of a lease. KCPL also admits that KCPL and Maurice Banks have had several discussions regarding his request for electric service. KCPL denies the remaining allegations contained in paragraph two.
  - 4. KCPL admits the allegations contained in paragraph three.

For its other and further Answer and defense, KCPL states and alleges the following:

- 5. On or about October 27, 1999, Maurice Banks contacted KCPL, and requested electric service at a commercial establishment located at 6950 Prospect Avenue, Kansas Čity, MO (the "Premises"). During this discussion, Maurice Banks was informed that since Ray Cartwright ("Mr. Cartwright") operates a business out of the Premises, Mr. Cartwright's past debts would have to be paid before KCPL would provide electric service to the Premises. At last count, Mr. Cartwright's unpaid debt owed to KCPL exceeds \$30,000.
- 6. Mr. Cartwright's history with KCPL goes back at least ten years. During this period, Mr. Cartwright has used numerous aliases<sup>1</sup>, strawmen and business entities to receive electric service from KCPL. During this period, Mr. Cartwright, through the use of subterfuge, has obtained electric service from KCPL at various locations in the Kansas City area, including the Premises. In many cases, Mr. Cartwright failed to pay his electric bills. As of October 27, 1999, and assuming that a five-year statute of limitation governs KCPL's causes of action, Mr. Cartwright owes KCPL approximately \$13,538.27.
- 7. Upon information and belief, certain members of Maurice Banks' family have been involved in some Mr. Cartwright's business ventures. Vernon Banks ("Mr. Banks") has claimed that he is the owner of record of the Premises. Upon information and belief, and in his purported capacity as owner of the Premises, Mr. Banks leased the Premises to Mr. Cartwright in the past. In addition, on October 22, 1998, Mr. Banks informed KCPL that he owned a 25% interest in the business located at the Premises. At the time this discussion took place, Mr. Banks was attempting to secure electric

service at the Premises for a gentleman named Chuck Freeman. Mr. Banks clamed that Mr. Cartwright was not the owner of the business being operated at the Premises, and that Mr. Cartwright was merely helping Mr. Freeman learn the business. KCPL suspects that Chuck Freeman is one of Mr. Cartwright's aliases.

- 8. Upon information and belief, Maurice Banks is Mr. Banks' son.
- 9. There is substantial evidence that demonstrates that Mr. Cartwright would benefit from electric service if KCPL were to provide service at the Premises:
  - a) The publication "It The Talk Of The Town" contains an advertisement for a restaurant operated by Mr. Cartwright out of the Premises ("Advertisement"). A copy of the Advertisement is attached hereto as Exhibit A.
  - b) The Advertisement states that the name of the restaurant is "Raychef B.B.Q. and Soul Food Diner."
  - c) The Advertisement lists the restaurant's address as "6950 Prospect."
  - d) On or about July, 1998, telephone service for Ray's Chef Diner ((816) 822-4080) was established under the name of "Chuck Freeman." As previously noted, KCPL believes that "Chuck Freeman" is one of the aliases used by Mr. Cartwright. On or about December 22, 1999, the telephone service at the Premises was taken out of "Chuck Freeman's" name and placed in Maurice Banks' name. Please note that the telephone number listed above recently has been disconnected.
  - e) KCPL employees have spoken to Mr. Cartwright via telephone at the Premises.
  - f) As of November 2, 1999, Mr. Cartwright was receiving mail at the Premises.
  - g) Mr. Cartwright has distributed advertisements that promote Ray Chef's Diner and list the diner's address as 6950 Prospect Street, Kansas City, MO. A copy of said advertisement is attached hereto as Exhibit B.

10. The information listed above is merely a portion of the evidence that demonstrates that Mr. Cartwright would benefit from electric service if KCPL were to provide electric service to the Premises. Until Mr. Cartwright's prior debts are paid, he is not entitled to electric service at the Premises or any other location within KCPL service territory.

WHEREFORE, KCPL prays that the Commission:

- a) deny each and every claim for relief presented by the complainant and dismiss his complaint; and
- b) provide such other and further relief as the Commission may deem just.
