Post-hearing briefs are currently due on December 14, 2007,¹ in the above captioned matter. On November 28, Missouri Gas Energy (“MGE”) moved for an extension of time requesting that the deadline for post-hearing briefs be extended to December 21. MGE asserts that scheduling conflicts are the reason for its request, and represents that counsel for all parties have no objections to the extension. The Commission finds MGE’s request to be reasonable and shall grant it.

4. Any party wishing to file proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law shall do so no later than December 21, 2007.

5. Any party filing proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law shall provide an electronic copy of their filing, in Microsoft Word format, to the regulatory law judge at harold.stearley@psc.mo.gov.

6. This order shall become effective on November 28, 2007.
