ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE AND SETTING DATE FOR SUBMISSION OF INTERVENTION REQUESTS

On January 14, 2009, Missouri Gas Utility, Inc. (MGU), filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission requesting that the Commission grant MGU authority to provide natural gas sales and transportation service to customers in the cities of Green Ridge, Cole Camp, Lincoln, and Warsaw, Missouri, and various unincorporated areas located in Pettis County and Benton County. In addition, MGU requests that the Commission grant it a "line" certificate from the tap on the Southern Star Central Pipeline in Section 35, Township 46 North, Range 23 West, to its requested general service area. Attached to its application as Appendix A is a map of the proposed service area. According to MGU's application, natural gas service is not presently available to residents in the proposed certificated area with the exception of the area for which it requests a line certificate only.

The Commission finds that notice of MGU's application should be given to the general public and potential interested parties and that a date for intervention of proper

parties should be set. The Commission's Data Center shall mail a copy of this notice to the county commissions of Pettis and Benton Counties. The Data Center shall also send a copy of this notice to the landowners listed in Appendix C of the application, as well as to Southern Star Pipeline, and to The Empire District Electric Company. In addition, the Commission's public information officer shall make notice of this order available to the media serving Pettis and Benton Counties and to the members of the General Assembly representing Pettis and Benton Counties.

The requirement of a hearing has been fulfilled when all those having a desire to be heard are offered an opportunity to be heard. If no proper party or governmental entity is granted intervention and neither the Staff of the Commission nor the Office of the Public Counsel requests a hearing, the Commission may determine that a hearing is not necessary and decide the case on the basis of the verified application and Staff recommendation.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Commission's Data Center shall mail a copy of this notice to the county commissions of Pettis and Benton Counties, the landowners listed in Appendix C of the application, Southern Star Pipeline, and to The Empire District Electric Company.
- 2. The Missouri Public Service Commission's public information officer shall make notice of this order available to the media serving Pettis and Benton Counties and to the members of the General Assembly representing Pettis and Benton Counties.
- 3. Any person wishing to intervene in this matter shall file an application to do so no later than February 9, 2009. Such applications shall be filed with:
