## ORDER APPROVING COMPLIANCE TARIFFS

The Missouri Public Service Commission is approving the tariff sheets ("tariff") filed in compliance with the Commission's directive ("tariff").

On March 31, 2010, the Commission granted Missouri Gas Utility, Inc., a certificate of convenience and necessity subject to conditions. In compliance with those conditions, Missouri Gas Utility, Inc. filed the tariff on May 10, 2010. On May 25, 2010, Staff filed its recommendation in favor of approving the tariff.

On review of the tariff and Staff's verified recommendation, the Commission independently finds and concludes that the tariff establishes safe and adequate service at just and reasonable rates, so the Commission will approve the tariff.
