NOTICE THAT SPIRE MISSOURI, INC. D/B/A SPIRE HAS WITHDRAWN APPLICATION FOR WHOLE BARRY COUNTY CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY AND ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On May 10, 2021,¹ the Commission conducted a procedural conference, and on June 7 the parties filed a Joint Status Report advising the Commission that discussions continued and asking the Commission to allow them until June 21 to file a proposed procedural schedule, status report or other pleading. On June 7, the Commission granted the request. On June 21, Spire Missouri, Inc., d/b/a Spire (Spire) filed a Motion for Leave to Withdraw Portions of the Application for Certificate of Convenience and Necessity. Specifically, Spire withdrew its request for an entire Barry County certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN).

An applicant may voluntarily dismiss an application without an order of the Commission at any time before prepared testimony has been filed or oral evidence has been offered.² The Commission acknowledges that Spire has withdrawn that part of its

application requesting an entire Barry County CCN. The Commission will order the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule, status report, or other pleading.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than July 12, 2021, the parties shall file a proposed procedural schedule, status report, or other pleading.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
