## ORDER AND NOTICE

On October 26, 2016, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (“Ameren”) asked the Commission to allow Ameren to sell a transformer to Mercy Health East Communities, Southern Region (“Mercy Health”).

The Commission finds that notice of the application should be given to the general public and interested parties and a date for intervention of proper parties should be set. The Commission's Data Center shall mail a copy of this notice to the County Commission of Jefferson County. In addition, the Commission's public information officer shall make notice of this order available to the media serving Jefferson County and to the members of the General Assembly representing Jefferson County.

The requirement of a hearing has been fulfilled when all those having a desire to be heard are offered an opportunity to be heard. If no proper party or governmental entity is granted intervention, and neither the Commission's Staff nor the Office of the Public Counsel requests a hearing, the Commission may determine that a hearing is not necessary for a determination on the application.<sup>1</sup>
