On April 13, 2017, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed its 2016 Renewable Energy Standard Compliance Report and 2017 Compliance Plan, as required by Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.100(8). The Missouri Department of Economic Development, Division of Energy (DE), and the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers (MIEC) applied to intervene on April 19.

This is not a contested case, and any interested person or entity may file comments regarding Ameren Missouri's report or plan without the necessity of applying to be a party to this proceeding.
