On April 13, 2017, Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCP&L) filed its 2017 Renewable Energy Standard Compliance Plan, as required by Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.100(8). The Missouri Department of Economic Development, Division of Energy applied to intervene on April 19.

This is not a contested case, and any interested person or entity may file comments regarding KCP&L's plan without the necessity of applying to be a party to this proceeding. However, under the Commission's confidential information rule, 4 CSR 240-2.135, confidential information may only be disclosed to a party. Therefore, DE must be made a party if it is to see the confidential portions of KCP&L's plan.

The Commission finds that allowing DE to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(3), the Commission will grant DE's application to intervene.

1. The Missouri Division of Energy's Application to Intervene is granted.
