ORDER CORRECTING ORDER

On November 1, 2017, the Commission issued an Order Establishing Special Contemporary Resource Planning Issues, which directed KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (GMO) to address a list of issues in its 2018 Triennial IRP Filing. Paragraph 1.S of that order directed GMO to address the impact of a possible early retirement of the Montrose coal plant. KCP&L owns an interest in Montrose, but GMO does not. GMO does own an interest in the Sibley and Lake Road coal plants and the order should have directed GMO to address the possible early retirement of those plants, not Montrose.

The Commission will correct the order accordingly.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Ordered paragraph 1.S of the Order Establishing Special Contemporary Resource Planning Issues is corrected to read: "Provide an explanation of stranded costs and ratepayer impact for the premature retirement of the Sibley and Lake Road coal plants
...."

2. This order shall be effective when issued.


