- 1. Do any of the supporting schedules and analysis from workpaper "HC BAM Summit Case Work Papers HC" include customer counts and volumes associated with the communities of:
- 1) Licking;
- 2) Houston;
- 3) Mountain View;
- 4) Buffalo; and,
- 5) Boliver.

If so, please provide the number of customers and the volumes included, and identify in which tabs they are included in "HC BAM Summit Case Work Papers HC".

RESPONSE:

Licking, Houston and Mountain View were included in the feasibility studies in Case No. GA-94-127. The workpaper worksheet with the tab label GA-94-127 GA-95-349 GA-2007-310 reflects the imputed customer counts and class volumes from Revised Schedule 1-1 from the testimony of Staff witness David Winter studies in Case No. GA-94-127. The Revised Schedule, which was marked as Exhibit 17, supported the stipulated volume of 1,797,000 in Case No. GA-94-127. The class customer counts and volumes were not broken out by service area in Revised Schedule 1-1. Case No. GA-2005-0349 and Case No. GA-2007-310 also related to Licking, Houston and Mountain View. I reviewed late filed Exhibit 3, the feasibility study in Case No. GA-2005-0349, but did not use the volumes as altered from the previous imputed volumes. I reviewed the Application and attached feasibility study in Case No. GA-2007-0310, but did not use the volumes as altered from the previous imputed volumes.
