The Innsbrook Estates Subdivision is classified as a public water supply by Missouri public drinking water regulations (10 CSR 60-2.015). This office oversees all public water supplies to insure proper monitoring is performed. We would like to take this opportunity to explain the monitoring programs that are required for your water supply. These monitoring programs help us work with you to provide safe drinking water for your residents.

To track your records, we have assigned a unique identification number, 6036142, to Innsbrook Estates. Always use this number to identify water samples and when corresponding with this office. A Bacteriological Water Analysis card is attached as an example.

Two samples must be submitted every other week for bacteriological analysis. You should collect one sample of finished
water at the well and the other from a point on the distribution
system. Follow schedule A (attached) which is marked with the
weeks you should collect these samples. This calendar is merely
a guide for you to follow. Always be sure to submit at least
four samples each month. Sample bottles and instructions will
be shipped to you soon if you have not already received them.

You will also need to send water samples for chemical analysis every three years. The Department of Health Laboratory will provide sample bottles when your analysis is scheduled. In addition, radiological testing is required at four year intervals. Instructions on radionuclide sampling are enclosed.

At this time, state law requires us to charge an annual fee for the laboratory services provided. The fee for your water system will be \$80.00 per year. We will bill you in January, 1988 for laboratory services provided during the 1987 calendar year.
