#### ORDER APPROVING UNANIMOUS STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT

Issue Date: February 28, 2018 Effective Date: March 12, 2018

On February 23, 2018, Matt Mylott, The Empire District Electric Company ("Empire"), White River Valley Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("White River"), and the Staff of the Commission ("Staff') filed a unanimous stipulation and agreement resolving all issues regarding Mr. Mylott's application for a change of electric supplier.

On November 2, 2017, Mr. Mylott filed an Application with the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission"), requesting the Commission authorize a change of electric service supplier from Empire to White River. Mr. Mylott owns property at 20577 State Highway 413, Reeds Spring, Missouri. There are four structures on the property; three are served by White River and one by Empire. Mr. Mylott desires to have all of his structures served by White River. Currently Empire provides single phase service to one of the four structures. Mr. Mylott wants three phase service for two of the structures, including the one served by Empire.

The stipulation and agreement provides that in exchange for Empire releasing Mr. Mylott and allowing him to change electric suppliers from Empire to White River, White River will make a one-time payment to Empire in the amount of \$6,200. This amount represents four years lost revenues as determined by estimating charges for electric service to the one building on the Property currently being served by Empire plus Empire's estimated cost of removing its facilities currently located on the property. White River's payment to Empire prevents Empire's other customers from being harmed by the change of supplier.

Staff, in its January 19, 2018, recommendation, found Mr. Mylott's request to have White River to be the sole electric service provider on his property is the quickest way for him to obtain three phase power, reduce the number of existing meters on his property, and prevent duplicative facilities. The change of supplier would be in the public interest for a reason other than a rate differential.

After reviewing the stipulation and agreement, the Commission independently finds and concludes that the stipulation and agreement is a reasonable resolution of the issue and that the stipulation and agreement should be approved. The effective date of the order will be March 12, 2018, to expedite Mr. Mylott's acquisition of three phase service.

#### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement filed on February 23, 2018, is approved. Matt Mylott is allowed to change electric service providers from The Empire District Electric Company to White River Electric Cooperative as detailed in the Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement. The parties are ordered to comply with the terms of the

stipulation and agreement. A copy of the stipulation and agreement is attached to this order and incorporated by reference.

2. This order shall be effective on March 12, 2018.

# <u>UNANIMOUS STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT REGARDING</u> APPLICATION FOR CHANGE OF ELECTRIC SERVICE PROVIDER

COME NOW the parties hereto, Matt Mylott ("Mr. Mylott" or "Customer"), The Empire District Electric Company ("Empire"), White River Valley Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("White River"), and the Staff of the Commission ("Staff") (collectively, the "Signatories"), and stipulate and agree as follows regarding the Application for Change of Electric Service Provider ("Application") filed herein by Mr. Mylott.

- 1. On November 2, 2017, Mr. Mylott filed his Application with the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission"), requesting the Commission authorize a change of the supplier of electric service from Empire to White River at 20577 State Highway 413, Reed Spring, Missouri (the "Property").
- 2. On November 6, 2017, the Commission issued its *Order Directing Notice, Adding Parties, and Directing Responses to Application* making Empire and White River parties to the case and directing Staff to file a recommendation.
- 3. Mr. Mylott recently acquired the Property which is located just south of Reed Springs, Missouri, with four existing structures; three of which are served by White River, and one by Empire. Mr. Mylott wishes to have three phase service provided to two buildings on his property; one of these structures currently receives single phase service from Empire. Mr. Mylott requests to have the three phase service provided expeditiously and requests that White River be the sole electric service provider for the Property.

- 4. White River filed a response to the Application, stating its desire and ability to be the exclusive electric service provider for the Property.
- 5. Empire filed a response to the Application, requesting that the Commission deny the Application. Empire stated that it has the right, pursuant to RSMo. §393.106, to continue as the electric service provider for the structure on the Property currently being served by Empire. Empire began providing permanent service to said structure in July of 2004. Empire further stated that it stands ready, willing, and able to provide three phase service to the Property.
- 6. Staff conducted an investigation and reviewed the information submitted in this case file. On January 19, 2018, Staff filed its Recommendation with Staff's Memorandum attached as Appendix A, recommending approval of the Application as being in the public interest for reasons other than a rate differential.
- 7. In exchange for Empire "releasing" this Customer and allowing the Customer to change electric suppliers from Empire to White River, White River will make a one-time payment to Empire in the amount of \$6,200. This amount represents four years' of "lost revenues" determined by estimating charges for electric service to the one building on the Property currently being served by Empire plus Empire's estimated cost of removing its facilities currently located on the Property.
- 8. Due to the payment to be made by White River to Empire, Empire's remaining retail customers will not be harmed by the Customer changing electric suppliers. As such, the Commission's approval of this Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement is in the public interest.

WHEREFORE, the Signatories enter into this Stipulation and Agreement and respectfully request the Commission's approval thereof.
