## ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL CONFERENCE

On April 30, 2018, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) submitted its first Missouri Energy Efficiency Investment Act (MEEIA) Cycle 2 prudence review report for Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri. The report contains proposed adjustments with a total disallowance of \$79,313. On May 3, 2018, Ameren Missouri requested a hearing. In addition, Ameren Missouri requested that the Commission set a date for a procedural conference for the purpose of discussing settlement and, if necessary, a procedural schedule. The Commission will grant the request for a procedural conference as set out below.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The parties shall appear at a procedural conference to be held on June 12, 2018 at 9:00 a.m.
2. The procedural conference will convene in Room 305 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102. The building meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. 3. This order shall be effective when issued.
