The Commission opened this file for its Staff to report on the events related to the February 2021 cold weather event and the preparation and response by Missouri's electrical and natural gas utilities. The Commission ordered its Staff to file a report no later than April 22, 2021. On April 21, 2021, Staff filed a Motion for Additional Time to File Report.

Staff explains that it has issued and is reviewing some 363 data requests in an effort to compile and file its report. Staff asks for an additional eight calendar days, until April 30, 2021, to file its report. Staff finds the motion reasonable, and will grant it.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Staff's motion is granted.
2. Staff shall file its report no later than April 30, 2021.
3. This order shall become effective when issued.
