1	INTRODUCTION			
2	Q.	Please state your name and business address.		
3	A.	My name is Mark D. Harper. My business address is 6450 Sprint Parkway,		
4		Overland Park, KS, 66251.		
5				
6	Q.	By whom are you employed and what are your duties?		
7	A.	I am employed by Sprint/United Management Company as Director-State		
8		Regulatory. In this position I am responsible for the development and		
9		implementation of state regulatory policy and strategy as it pertains to Sprint's		
10		operations in fourteen Midwest states including Missouri.		
11				
12	Q.	Have you previously testified?		
13	A.	Yes, I testified in Case Nos. TW-97-333, TO-97-217, TR-93-181, TO-95-289, et		
14		al., TC-96-112, TT-96-398, TO-97-253 and T0-98-329 before this Commission		
15		and have testified in regulatory proceedings in Kansas and Texas.		
16				
17	Q.	Please summarize your educational background and relevant work		
18		experience?		
19	A.	I received a Bachelor of Science degree from Washington State University in		
20		Pullman, Washington in 1983. My major was in Business Administration with an		
21		emphasis in Finance.		
22		From 1983 to 1987, I was employed by the accounting firm of Ernst & Whinney		

in the Tacoma Telecommunications Group. In this job I provided consulting

services to telephone companies in the United States and Puerto Rico. My clients ranged from independent telephone companies with fewer than 1,000 access lines to regional bell operating companies. Services provided included the development of separations and access charge studies, negotiation of pool settlements, review of accounting systems for compliance with state and federal regulations, and the filing and support of rate cases.

In 1987, I joined United Telecommunications, Inc. (the predecessor to Sprint/United Management Company) as Manager-Cost Allocations. In this job I was responsible for the conformance of costing and access charge systems with Federal Communications Commission (FCC) rules and the preparation and support of the tariff review plan filed with the annual interstate access charge filing for all United LECs.

In 1988, I was promoted to the position of Director-Pricing and Tariffs. In this job, I was responsible for the development of pricing strategies for existing services and the introduction of new services for the United LECs. I was also responsible the development and communication of policy on intrastate issues. In 1992, I joined United Telephone-Midwest as Director-Revenue for its Missouri operations. In this position, I was responsible for the regulatory relations, exchange carrier relations, pricing, costing and tariffs in the State of Missouri. In 1996, my duties were expanded to include Kansas. In January 1999 I began my current position.

II. PURPOSE OF TESTIMONY

7 Q. What is the purpose of your testimony?

My purpose is to present Sprint's position regarding the effective competition that
exists for several of Sprint's statewide service offerings. As a result of this case,
those services that are facing effective competition will be granted competitive
status. Sprint witness, John R. Idoux, addresses the overall state of competition
for Sprint in Missouri and supports the finding of effective competition in specific
Sprint exchanges.

Q. If the Commission recognizes that these services are subject to effective competition, what would be the result?

A. Services that are deemed competitive will no longer be subject to the maximum allowable prices under 392.245.4 and 392.245.11 and not be subject to 392.200.4(c)(2). The result will be the ability to lower or raise prices as the company deems appropriate in the competitive environment. Customers will be served through more responsive pricing and ultimately markets are more efficient as pricing moves towards economic costs.

1	Q.	Please summarize the list of services for which Sprint is seeking competitive

22	Q.	The Commission previously addressed the state of competition including
23		some services on a statewide basis, for Southwestern Bell Telephone (SWBT)
24		in Case No. TO-2001-467 (SWBT Competition Case). How does the list you
25		have presented compare to the Commission's conclusions in that case?
26		A. With a few limited exceptions, the list of services for which Sprint is
27		seeking state-wide competitive classification is consistent with the Order in that
2.1		seeking state wide competitive endamental is consistent with the Order in that
28		the SWBT Competition Case. Sprint's services are functionally equivalent to
29		those of SWBT and face the same types of competitors throughout its territory
30		and therefore should be deemed competitive. Sprint is requesting that the
31		Commission deem Directory Assistance services and Centrex subject to effective
32		competition. Sprint's evidence demonstrates that competition for these services is

1		not linked to the provider of local service and multiple alternatives are available
2		throughout Sprint's territory.
3		
4	SECT	TON II – COMPETITION FOR STATEWIDE SERVICE
5	Q.	What is the purpose of this section of your testimony?
6	A.	I will address each of the services identified above in this section. In addressing
7		whether or not effective competition exists, I will not repeat testimony provided
8		by Mr. Idoux as to what criteria the Commission should apply. Instead, I will cite
9		to facts that I believe address the criteria identified by Mr. Idoux.
10		
12		
13	MESS	SAGE TOLL SERVICES (MTS) AND WATS TARIFF
14		
15		
16	Q.	What services are included in the MTS tariff?
17	A.	The services in the tariff are specifically listed above. This tariff contains what is,
18		in essence, Sprint's intraLATA toll service. These services furnish interexchange
19		telecommunications on a dial basis between points in different local service areas
20		within the same LATA. These services are offered to both residential and
21		business customers.
22		
23	Q.	Please summarize why Sprint believes the MTS services are subject to
24		effective competition?
25	Α.	The basic supporting facts are:

1		• Currently, there are at least 586 interexchange carriers ("IXCs")
2		certified in Missouri to provide intrastate interexchange service. This
3		includes many that offer both intraLATA and interLATA toll service.
4		• Sprint began the implementation of intraLATA toll dialing parity in
5		August 1997 and as a result all intraLATA toll providers can offer
6		customers the ability to make intraLATA calls through their carrier of
7		choice without dialing extra digits.
8		• There are also several non-traditional forms of competition that
9		contribute to the effective competition in intraLATA services
10		including wireless services, prepaid telephone cards and Internet
11		telephony.
12		The Commission has repeatedly ruled that intraLATA toll services are
13		competitive including the SWBT Competition Docket. Competitive
14		status would place Sprint on a level playing field with its competitors.
15		
16	Q.	What types of traditional competition do Sprint MTS, intraLATA Toll
17		services face?
18	A.	Currently there are at least 586 IXCs certified to provide intrastate, intraLATA
19		service in Missouri according to the Commission website. A list of IXCs certified
20		in Missouri is attached to my testimony as Schedule MDH-1. The service
21		offerings of these carriers can be found in the tariffs on file with the Commission.
22		CLECs also offer intraLATA toll services either through an affiliated IXC or they

may offer customers a choice of interexchange carriers. These competitors are

traditional in that they have competed in this marketplace for a long period of time and generally utilize the same access methods. In other words, the services are equivalent and substitutable. The intraLATA toll market includes IXCs that offer both intraLATA and interLATA toll services. Attached as Schedule MDH-2 are samples of advertising and other marketing materials utilized by some of Sprint's competitors. These carriers, and now SWBT, are designated competitive companies providing equivalent and substitutable services and there is no basis for not designating Sprint's intraLATA toll service as competitive as well.

Α.

Q. Can the IXCs listed on Schedule 1 provide intraLATA toll without customer dialing extra digits?

Yes. Sprint began the implementation of intraLATA presubscription in August 1997 and as a result customers have the ability to reach the IXC of their choice without dialing any extra digits. Therefore, most Sprint customers in Missouri have had this capability for over five years.

Q. What type of non-traditional alternative providers offers services that compete with intraLATA toll?

The nontraditional providers include wireless service, which offers larger local calling scopes, prepaid phone cards and the internet. Being labeled non-traditional in no sense lessens the competitive impact of these carriers or the appeal to customers. Attached as Schedule MDH-3 are copies of some of the wireless offerings available in Sprint's territories in Missouri. You will note that many of

1		them include unlimited on network long distance as part of the service package.				
2		Further, attached to my testimony as Schedule MDH-4 is a copy of some of the				
3		prepaid calling card offers available in Sprint's territories in Missouri. Finally,				
4		the use of the Internet telephony is growing. The presence of these non-				
5		traditional competitors only provides additional support for the Commission's				
6		previous conclusion the intraLATA toll services are competitive.				
7						
8	Q.	What has been the impact of the competition for Sprint's intraLATA toll				
9		services?				
10	A.	Since 1999, Sprint's intraLATA toll minutes and revenues have declined 75% and				
11		76%, respectively. In December 2002, 52 different carriers were providing				
12		intrastate toll services to Sprint's local customers based on access billing.				
13		Further, even in Ionia, Sprint's exchange customers used 18 different carriers in				
14		that month. This would not include intra-MTA toll minutes carried by wireless				
15		carriers or other non-traditional carriers.				
16						
17	Q.	Has the Commission made any previous rulings whether effective				
18		competition exists state-wide for intraLATA toll services?				
19	A.	Yes. In the SWBT Competition Case the Commission stated that "competition				
20		has existed in the intraLATA toll market since July 1986, when the Commission				
21		authorized intraLATA toll competition." This authorization applied statewide				
22		including Sprint's territory. Further, the Commission classified SWBT's				
23		intraLATA toll services as competitive in Case No. TO-2001-467. In making this				

1		ruling, the Commission noted the clear evidence supporting effective competition,
2		which was essentially the same as the evidence I have put forth above.
3		
18	Q.	What should the Commission find with respect to Sprint MTS, intraLATA
19		toll service?
20	A.	Based on the evidence presented above and consistent with its past rulings, the
21		Commission should clearly find that Sprint's MTS, intraLATA toll service is
22		subject to effective competition.
23		
24	Q.	What services are offered under the Wide Area Telecommunications
25		Services (WATS) tariff?
26	A.	WATS services include both 800 Service and Outward WATS, or OUTWATS.
27		800 Service provides for incoming calls to be toll-free for the calling party.
28		OUTWATS provides for outgoing calls to be billed on a usage sensitive basis.
29		
30	Q.	What is the basis for Sprint's request to have WATS services deemed
31		competitive?
32	A.	While these services may differ from MTS in the method or type of billing, they
33		are both, in the end, methods of calling between local calling areas within a
34		LATA. As such, WATS is also subject to competition from the interexchange
35		carriers certified in Missouri. For example, AT&T's WATS offerings can be
36		found in their PSC MO. NO. 14 tariff and MCI's can be found in M.P.S.C. Tariff
37		NO. 1. As early as 1993, the Commission found that the same services for SWBT

were substitutable for IXC service and as such were granted transitionally competitive status. In 1999 the services automatically became classified as competitive. The competitive status was reaffirmed in SWBT Competition Case. Sprint's services are functionally the same as those provided by SWBT as well as those services provided by its IXC competitors and should be deemed competitive.

Α.

Directory Assistance and Local Operator Assistance Services

Q. What is the purpose of this section of your testimony?

Sprint is seeking statewide competitive classification for all Directory Assistance and certain Local Operator Assistance related services, including Directory Assistance, National Directory Assistance and Call Completion Services (herein referred to collectively as "Directory Assistance" or "DA") and Local Operator Assistance Services (or "Operator Services"). The purpose of this section of my testimony is to describe the competitive landscape for Directory Assistance and Local Operator Services and to explain why it is appropriate for the Commission to deem these services as competitive for all of Sprint's Missouri exchanges. As my testimony will clearly demonstrate, there are numerous alternatives for Directory Assistance and Local Operator Services in Sprint's exchanges. Furthermore, Sprint faces effective competition for all of the Directory Assistance and Local Operator services in every Sprint exchange in Missouri. Consequently, it is appropriate for the Commission to deem Directory Assistance and Local Operator Assistance services as competitive services for Sprint.

Directory Assistance Services

3 Q. Turning first to the Directory Assistance Services, what specific Directory

4 Assistance services is Sprint seeking to have deemed as competitive services?

5 A. The following information lists the specific Directory Assistance services and the

corresponding references found in Sprint's General Exchange Tariff for the

7 services that Sprint is seeking competitive classification:

- 10 Q. Can you please describe these Directory Assistance services?
- 11 A. Yes, briefly they can be defined as follows:

1		Directory Assistance: A service furnished upon request by a customer wherein
2		assistance in determining directory listing information in the same local calling
3		area or in the same Home Numbering Plan Area (HNPA) is provided by the
4		Company.
5		
6		National Directory Assistance: A service that is provided to customers for the
7		purpose of requesting telephone numbers of individuals or businesses who are
8		located outside the customer's local Directory Assistance local calling service
9		area and outside the customer's Home Numbering Plan Area (HNPA)
10		
11		Directory Assistance Call Completion: An optional service that is provided to
12		customers wherein they may have their calls to the requested directory number
13		completed automatically by the Company's Operator Services System. The
14		calling number and the number requested to be completed must be in the same
15		LATA as the customer requesting the service.
16		
17	Q.	Has the Commission previously ruled on the competitive status of these
18		Directory Assistance Services?
19	A.	Yes. In the SWBT Competition Case, the Commission ruled "directory
20		assistance is so closely related to basic local service that it cannot be subject to
21		effective competition where basic local is not subject to effective competition".
22		

Q. Given this fact, why then is Sprint seeking competitive classification for Directory Assistance in this proceeding?

Sprint believes that the evidence in that case and in this current case demands a different conclusion. The fundamental question that the Commission must address is whether or not a Sprint Missouri consumer has access to directory assistance services from providers other than Sprint when Sprint retains the customer's basic local service. The answer to this question is clearly "yes" they can, and do. The Commission should carefully evaluate the availability of comparable services from multiple suppliers, the inability of a single provider to determine or control prices, ease and likelihood of market entry by competitors, and substitutability of one provider's service for another's. Every Sprint customer currently has multiple choices for Directory Assistance information. Clearly, in Missouri today, the customer can, and does, have effective competition for Directory Assistance even when the basic local service remains with Sprint. Therefore, the Commission should recognize this fact and find that Directory Assistance is competitive for Sprint.

A.

- Q. Are there examples of other services that are deemed competitive while at the same time the basic phone service remains with the incumbent local exchange carrier?
- Yes. A customer can choose a competitive toll provider but still retain Sprint as
 their basic local service provider. The same is true for the maintenance of inside
 wire. For voice mail, customers can choose the product offered by their local

1		exchange carrier or choose an alternative provider or purchase their own CPE -
2		all while maintaining Sprint as their primary provider of dial tone service.
3		
4	Q.	With respect to Directory Assistance Services, what are specific examples of
5		the alternatives available to Sprint's local customers in Missouri?
6	A.	There are numerous alternative providers offering Directory Assistance other than
7		the local exchange provider. With at least 586 interexchange service providers
8		certificated to provide service in the state of Missouri there are many alternative
9		providers. The alternative products offered by these providers are clearly
10		substitutable services, considering both function and price, to Sprint's DA
11		Services. These alternatives include, but are certainly not limited to, the
12		following:
13		
14		555-1212 Customers wanting to select their long distance provider to
15		provide DA other than Sprint can simply dial 1-area code-555-1212. This
16		call is routed to the customer's toll provider. For example, a Sprint
17		customer in Jefferson City (Jefferson City is a Sprint exchange) seeking
18		local directory assistance can simply dial 1-573-555-1212 to obtain
19		Directory Assistance information from a company other than Sprint. This
20		holds true irrespective of whether or not the end user has Sprint for its
21		basic dial tone service.
22		

1	Wireless - Wireless carriers throughout Missouri provide customers with							
2	both local and national directory assistance services. Wireless customers							
3	typica	lly access their carrier	r's Directory Service by	y dialing 411. Of course,

1	Q.	Given the multitude of alternatives available to customers in Missouri for
2		Directory Assistance, has Sprint experienced a decrease in its own Directory
3		Assistance call volumes?
4	A.	Yes. Sprint has experienced a substantial decrease in the number of Directory
5		Assistance calls. Since 1998, the volume of Directory Assistance calls handled by
6		Sprint has declined 36%.
7		
8	Q.	What is your conclusion regarding Directory Assistance?
9	A.	Given the vast number of alternative Directory Assistance providers, combined
10		with the dramatic decrease in call volumes experienced by Sprint in Missouri, it is
11		clear that Directory Assistance is currently subject to effective competition in all
12		exchanges throughout Missouri. Furthermore, it is abundantly clear that this
13		vigorous competition is occurring even when the end user remains a Sprint basic
14		customer. Therefore, the Commission should find that Directory Assistance
15		Services are a competitive service for Sprint.
16		
17	Loca	l Operator Services
18	Q.	With regard to Local Operator Services, can you describe the specific
19		services that Sprint is seeking to have the Commission deem as competitive in
20		Missouri?

1	A.	Yes. Operator Services refer to those services	, using live operators or automated				
2		systems that provide customers with various call completion options. Specifically,					
3		these services can be defined:

1		number" from any telephone. Customers generally make these types of calls when
2		they are away from their home and traveling.
3		
4	Q.	Has the Commission previously ruled on the competitive status of these
5		particular types of Operator Services?
6	A.	Yes. For Southwestern Bell, in Case No. TO-93-116 the Commission found
7		that these services were transitionally competitive under the terms of 392.370.2
8		RSMo. The Commission extended the initial three-year period for this
9		transitionally competitive status from January 10, 1996 to January 10, 1999. By
10		operation of law, these services became competitively classified for Bell at that
11		time. The Commission confirmed that these services were indeed competitive in
12		the Bell Competition Case (Case No. TO-2001-467)
13		
14	Q.	Has the Commission previously found Sprint's Operator Services to be
15		transitionally competitive?
16	A.	No, Sprint has not sought transitionally competitive status for these services in the
17		past in part because of the long arduous process in previous applications. Since
18		this case is for the purpose of determining the extent of effective competition for
19		Sprint's services, Sprint is now seeking recognition of the competitive status of
20		these services under the provisions of Section 392.245.
21		

1	Q.	is Sprint seeking statewide competitive status for these Operator Services in
2		this proceeding?
3	A.	Yes. Just as I have previously described in my testimony regarding Directory
4		Assistance services, consumers in Missouri have multiple alternative choices
5		for Operator Services. As mentioned, there are at least 586 interexchange service
6		providers that can and do provide these types of services. Alternative providers
7		include IXCs, wireless carriers, pay telephone providers and prepaid calling card
8		providers.
9		
10		In addition to IXCs such as AT&T and WorldCom, there are numerous other
11		providers of operator services in Missouri, including CLECs and wireless carriers.
12		See Schedule MDH-5 for a description of alternatives that are available to
13		Missouri consumers.
14		
15	Q.	Does the list of Local Operator Assistance services for which Sprint is
16		seeking statewide competitive classification include all Operator Services
17		provided by Sprint?
18	Α.	No. Sprint is <u>not</u> seeking statewide competitive classification for the following
19		Operator Services at this time:
20		1. Line Status Verification
21		2. Busy Line Interrupt

Sprint includes these two Operator Services in a category defined as Busy Verification Service in its Missouri General Exchange Tariff, Section 40.I.B.1.

3

4 Q. Please summarize this portion of your testimony.

As demonstrated above, Sprint's customers have numerous options for DA and Local Operator Assistance services throughout its service territory that are not linked to Sprint's provision of basic local service. The DA and Local Operator Assistance service available from the alternative providers is functionally equivalent to Sprint's services. There are no substantive barriers to entry or exit in these services and the recognition of the competitive status of these services will allow Sprint to more flexibly respond to competition and deliver greater value to its customers.

13 Centrex Service

14 Q. What is Centrex service?

15 A. Centrex service is a central office based system that allows business customers to
16 use Sprint's central office technology instead of purchasing their own switching
17 equipment. Centrex service is tariffed in Sprint's General Exchange Tariff and is
18 essentially the same as the Plexar service of SWBT. Centrex service provides
19 basic call processing capabilities as well as many optional features to be ordered
20 by the customer.

21

22

Q. What types of competition exist for Centrex Service?

Business customers have had competitive alternatives for Centrex for over five
years. PBX and key system hardware provide a direct substitute that is the
functional equivalent of the central office based switching platform. This
hardware can be purchased from a multitude of vendors throughout the state.

CLECs can offer Centrex-like services either through resale of Sprint's service or
through their own facilities.

Α.

Q. Are competitive alternatives to Centrex only available in exchanges where CLECs are competing?

No. As stated above, there is a large number of vendors located throughout the state that sell, install and maintain PBX and key system equipment. The most active competitors include SBC, Verizon, Intertel, Siemens, Avaya and Towner Communications. For example, Sprint lost over 4,000 Centrex lines in Warrensburg to a PBX that the customer purchased from Verizon Communications. While there are some customers utilizing CLECs in Warrensburg as far as Sprint is aware all lines utilize resale.

Α.

Q. How are PBX and Key systems functionally equivalent to Centrex service?

These systems replicate many of the features available from the central office in a premises based switch. The premise-based switch manages calls between stations on the premises without utilizing the central office switch and handles calls to and from the public switched network. They provide the same call management functions and many of the same or additional features.

3

2 Q. Is there additional evidence that effective competition exists statewide for

Centrex Service?

4 A. Yes, in 1996 the Missouri Legislature passed SB507 it included revisions to 392.200. Particularly, 392.200.8 allows all carriers to utilize customer specific pricing for central office based switching systems (Centrex). The introduction of this flexibility was designed to allow carriers to more effectively respond to competition and was consistent with the competitive market that existed for Centrex services then and now. The flexibility was available statewide.

Q. What should the Commission do regarding Centrex service?

12 A. Consistent with the finding of effective competition and the pricing flexibility
13 already allowed under statute, Centrex service should be found to be competitive
14 for Sprint statewide.

DEDICATED SERVICES

17 Q. What services do you include in this category?

In this section I will address ATM and Frame Relay Service as well as the Private

Line Mileage service found in the General Exchange Tariff. I will also address all

of the services found in the Private Line Tariff and the Special Access and related

services found in the Access Tariff. Product descriptions can be found in Sprint's

tariffs.

Why have you grouped these services together? Q.

A. All of these services are dedicated in the sense that they provide service originating from a specific location over a specific technology. The services are also based on well-defined industry standards followed by all providers. They each are designed to meet a customers need to transport data, voice or video to a specific point or points. That being said, technology and customer need are ever 6 changing and many customers' required bandwidth needs are continually 7 increasing causing a convergence of service types over time. 8 Each of these services faces competition from essentially the same group of 9

competitors and thus should be addressed together.

Finally, this Commission has previously recognized in Case NO. TO-93-116 that these services are substitutable for the services provided by IXCs and recently affirmed in TO-2001-467 that competitive status.

Q. What competitors does Sprint face for these dedicated services?

A. The competitors for these services include IXCs such as AT&T, MCI, and Qwest. SWBT's affiliate ASI also competes for these services in Sprint's territory. Network integrators such as IBM also are actively involved in this marketplace. Facilities based CLECs such as Fidelity and Unite provide competing services over their own facilities while other CLECs can utilize resale or UNEs to provide service to their customers. In addition, fiber providers such as DTI (now owned by CenturyTel) and Electric Coops such as Show-me Power have placed fiber through Sprint's territory and lease circuits on these networks directly to customers. In fact, Sprint even purchases facilities from these competitors.

Attached as Schedule MDH-6 are the maps and service descriptions for Show-Me

Power, Cooperative's Broadband Network, and DTI, each has fiber traversing

Sprint's territory and offer like products to the public. Further information about their offerings can be found on the web at www.cbn.coop and www.cbn.coop and

A.

Q. Do these providers present effective competition?

Yes. The products are substitutable between the competitors and Sprint. Sprint is routinely faced with situations where customers are weighing multiple quotes from multiple providers for like products. Within the past year Sprint has lost the right to continue to provision an extensive integrated voice and data network for the State of Missouri to a provider affiliated with SWBT. Also, Sprint has lost several contracts for circuits to connect schools with MORENET to Show-Me Power. The fact that customers are choosing other providers demonstrates the competitive nature of these products as well as their substitutability.

COMMON CHANNEL SIGNALING/SS7 AND LINE INFORMATION DATA BASE

Q. Please describe SS7 and Line Information Data Base (LIDB) services?

A. The customer for these services is other carriers. SS7 service provides a dedicated two-way signaling path between a customer and Sprint's Signal Transfer Point and provides access to Sprint's SS7 network. SS7 signaling is used to carry the signals and associated information for switched access calls in a path that is

separate from the voice call. SS7 is also utilized to access call processing 1 2 databases such LIDB, 800 and number portability. 3 LIDB Service provides the customer the ability to query a billing validation database prior to completion of an alternate billed called such as Calling Card. 4 5 collect and third number billing. The database aids in assuring the call is authorized and billed to the proper party. 6 7 8 Q. Does Sprint face effective competition for these services? A. 9 Yes, Sprint faces competition for both of these services from the SBC subsidiary 10 SNET, Illuminet (now called Verisign) and TSI Telecommunications Services. Each of these carriers has their own nationwide SS7 Network and databases and 11 can provision the services to any carrier. Attached as Schedule MDH-7 is 12 information from each provider's website regarding service offerings. Just as the 13 14 Commission found in the SWBT Competition Case, effective competition exists 15 for these services in Sprint's territory statewide. 16 17 SERVICES REPLICATED BY CUSTOMER PREMISES EQUIPMENT Q. What services comprise this category? 18 Α. This category is made up of Custom Calling services that are completely 19 20 replicated by widely available customer premises equipment (CPE). Speed Calling 8 and Speed Calling 30 allow customer to load a speed dialing list 21 22 utilizing storage in the company's central office.

1	Q.	Do these custom calling features face effective competition statewide?
2	A.	Yes, as the Commission has previously found for SWBT's Speed Calling 8 and
3		Speed Calling 30, CPE is widely available from retail outlets throughout the state,
4		which contain features that are functionally equivalent to and substitutable for
5		Sprint's service. Sprint requests that the Commission find that effective
6		competition exists for these features.
7		
8	CON	CLUSION '
9	Q.	Could you please summarize your direct testimony?
10	A.	I have set the rationale for the granting of competitive status for a number of
11		Sprint's services. In particular, the Commission should designate Sprint's MTS,
12		WATS, Operator Services, Private Line, Special Access, ATM, Frame Relay and
13		Speed Dialing services as competitive for all Sprint exchanges based on the
14		evidence of effective competition from numerous carriers and other vendors; and
15		the fact that these services are functionally equivalent to those deemed
16		competitive for SWBT and competitive carriers.
17		
18		The Commission should designate Sprint's SS7 and LIDB services as competitive
19		for all Sprint exchanges based on the availability of alternative vendors providing
20		substitutable services consistent with its ruling in the SWBT Competition Case.
21		The Commission should designate Directory Assistance and Centrex services as
22		competitive for all Sprint exchanges based in the availability of alternative

services that functionally equivalent throughout Sprint's territory.

Why are electric cooperatives becoming involved in the telecommunications business?

The Cooperatives' Broadband Network has access to several Internet Service Providers (ISPs) and can deliver high-speed connections via fiber optic cable and wireless links.



About Sho-Me

STRUCTURE

The Coop structure consists of four levels, Generation Coop, Transmission Coop, Distribution Coop, and the consumers or members. The Generation Coop creates the power used by its member Transmission Coops who transport the power to its Distribution Coops, who in turn sell the power to their members or consumers.

The consumers of the area came together and formed the Distribution Coops to provide the power necessary for the rural areas. The Distribution Coops formed Transmission Coops to supply the power they deemed necessary for their members, and the Transmission Coops formed a Generation Coop to generate the power needed in the area.

In Southwest Missouri the Generation Coop is Associated Electric, the Transmission Coop is Sho-Me Power, and there are nine Distribution Coops. The entire Coop structure is set up to provide power to its members at the lowest prices possible. Sho-Me is a non-profit organization.

Questions & Answers Regarding Fiber Optics and Sho-Me Technologies, L.L.C.

Q Why is Sho-Me Forming a Limited Liability Company?

A Missouri state law does not allow a rural electric cooperative to do anything but sell electrical energy. Sho-Me Technologies, L.L.C. has been formed and is regulated by the Missouri Public Service Commission to provide dedicated, point to point, non-switched telecommunication services in the state of Missouri.

Q Why is Sho-Me Installing Fiber Optic Cable?

A Sho-Me uses 2 GHz microwave to control and operate its power system. The federal government has sold Sho-Me's frequencies to private companies, such as AT&T, who are installing wireless Personal Communication Services. So the federal government has really forced Sho-Me to install fiber.

Q How will the fiber be used?

A The primary use of the fiber will be to control Sho-Me's electrical system. Any excess capacity and/or fiber will be available to lease. Sho-Me can lease capacity, such as a DS-1,DS-3,OC-3 or dark fiber.

Q Will Sho-Me Make A Lot of Money?


A No, Sho-Me will not earn any profits. Actually, Sho-Me will be very fortunate to breakeven over the next five years. Any funds generated in excess of expenses will either be reinvested in the system or returned to Sho-Me's owners. Sho-Me's owners can then either invest in their system or return money to cooperative members.

Q With a fiber network in place what other services will be available in the future?

A Fiber Optics will allow a wide variety of electrical system functions, such as remote meter reading. Through partnerships people living in rural areas will enjoy the same privileges those in the city take for granted.
