We received yesterday Complainant's Responses to Respondent's Data Requests Including Objections Thereto ("Responses").¹

Our review of the Responses indicates that AT&T Missouri will need to file a motion to compel further responses to the Data Requests, pursuant to Commission Rule 2.090 (8), unless we reach a satisfactory mutual agreement as a result of either a telephone or in-person conference, as is required by the rule.
