# Title 4 – Department of Economic Development Division 240 –Public Service Commission Chapter 13—Service and Billing Practices for Residential Customers of Electric, Gas and Water Utilities

#### ORDER OF RULEMAKING

By the authority vested in the Public Service Commission (Commission or PSC) under sections 386.250 and 392.140, RSMo 2000, the Commission amends a rule as follows:

#### 4 CSR 240-13.015 Definitions is amended.

A notice of the proposed rulemaking containing the text of the proposed amendment was published in the *Missouri Register* on May 3, 2004 (*Missouri Register*, Vol. 29, No. 9). A public hearing was held on June 7, 2004. There are no changes to the rule as a result of the hearing. This proposed amendment becomes effective thirty (30) days after publication in the *Code of State Regulations*.

SUMMARY OF COMMENTS: A public hearing was held on June 7, 2004. The time for submission of written comments ended June 2, 2004. The Commission received no written comments. At the public hearing, Gay Fred, Manager of the Consumer Services Department of the Commission, explained that the amendment is designed to provide specific definitions to provide clarification so that the rules in Chapter 13 may be applied consistently to all parties or all consumers. John B. Coffman, Public Counsel, Office of the Public Counsel, stated at the public hearing that Office of the Public Counsel supports the amendment to this rule, and generally supports the Denial of Service Rule. At the public hearing the Commission asked clarifying questions.

No written comments were received during the thirty (30) day comment period. Comments made at the public hearing related to: the need for addition of two (2) definitions to the definitions section of this rule.

COMMENT: The Commission received one (1) comment from Gay Fred that the addition of the two definitions to the Definitions section of Chapter 13 adds clarity to the rule and allows for uniform application of the rule.

RESPONSE: As a result of this comment no change was made to the rule.

COMMENT: John B. Coffman, Public Counsel, commented that the Public Counsel has no problem with the proposed amendment and no objection to the rule.

RESPONSE: As a result of this comment, no changes were made to the rule.
