On April 15, 2016, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed its 2015 Renewable Energy Standard Compliance Report and 2016-2018 Renewable Energy Standard Compliance Plan, as required by Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.100(8). The Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers (MIEC) applied to intervene on April 26.

This is not a contested case, and stakeholders do not need to be parties to file comments as allowed by the Commission's regulation. However, unless it is made a party, MIEC will not be able to view the highly confidential portions of the company's filings. Before ruling on the application to intervene, the Commission will establish a shortened time for responses to that application.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any party wishing to respond to the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers' application to intervene shall do so no later than April 28, 2016.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
