On April 15, 2016, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed its 2015 Renewable Energy Standard Compliance Report and 2016-2018 Renewable Energy Standard Compliance Plan, as required by Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.100(8). The Commission's Staff, Earth Island Institute, d/b/a Renew Missouri, and United For Missouri, Inc., filed responses to Ameren Missouri's 2016-2018 Plan on May 27, 2016. Staff has filed a request for extension of time until June 10 to file its response to Ameren Missouri's 2015 RES Compliance Report. Staff's motion represents that no party objects to the proposed extension.

The Commission will grant the extension requested by Staff, and will allow all other parties additional time to file a report if they wish to do so.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Staff's Motion for Extension of Time to File its Report on Ameren Missouri's 2015 RES Compliance Report is granted.
2. Any party wishing to file comments regarding Ameren Missouri's 2015 RES Compliance Report is allowed until June 10, 2016 to do so.
