ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND

On September 25, 2017, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed its 2017 Integrated Resource Plan, as required by the Commission's Electric Utility Resource Planning Rule, 4 CSR 240-22. Subsection 22.080(7) requires the Commission's Staff to review Ameren Missouri's IRP filing and to file a report 150 days after the utility's "scheduled triennial compliance filing date." Subsection 22.080(8) establishes an identical 150-day filing date for the filing of a report by Public Counsel and any intervenors. Staff filed a motion on October 4, asking the Commission to establish February 26, 2018 as the 150-day filing date, measured from September 29, the Friday before Sunday, October 1. No one has responded to Staff's motion.

The regulation provides that the 150-day period is measured from the date Ameren Missouri was scheduled to make its IRP filling, which was October 1, 2017. The fact that Ameren Missouri actually filed its IRP six days early, does not affect the response time; neither does the fact that October 1 was a Sunday. One hundred and fifty days after October 1, 2017 is February 28, 2018. That is the day when responsive reports are due.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Commission's Staff shall file its report regarding Ameren Missouri's IRP no later than February 28, 2018.
- 2. Any other party wishing to file a report regarding Ameren Missouri's IRP shall do so no later than February 28, 2018.
 - 3. This order shall be effective when issued.
