 Solar Water Heaters: Residential - \$750; Non-residential & Multi-family - \$15 per 1,000 BTU/day, Solar Air Heaters \$250

Maximum Incentive: PV: Residential - \$20,000; Non-residential - \$100,000

Solar Water Heaters: Residential - \$750; Non-residential & Multi-family - \$5,000, Solar Air Heaters \$250
