No updates or changes are necessary. The red-lined updates referred to in this data request relate to transactions resulting from a renewables project financed, at least in part, by tax equity financing. Although the Inflation Reduction Act reduces the instances in which a utility may seek tax equity financing for a project, there remain instances where it may be prudent to seek this sort of financing for future projects.
