Subject: Staff Recommendation to Approve Tariff Sheets Filed to Establish an Experimental

Natural Gas Water Heater and Furnace Rebate Program to Comply with the Missouri Public Commission Order Approving Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement in Case

No. GC-2006-0180 Effective April 21, 2006.

On April 12, 2006, Southern Missouri Gas Company, LP d/b/a Southern Missouri Natural Gas (SMNG or Company) filed tariff sheets to establish an Experimental Natural Gas Water Heater and Furnace Rebate Program (the Proposed Rebate Program). SMNG is filing these tariff sheets to establish the Proposed Rebate Program to comply with Provision (6) of the Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement approved by the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) in their Order of April 21, 2006, in Case No. GC-2006-0180. This Rebate Program augments and replaces the existing Experimental Natural Gas Water Heater Rebate Program (Existing Rebate Program) approved by the Commission in December 2005.

The purpose of the Proposed Rebate Program is to encourage more effective utilization of natural gas by encouraging energy efficiency improvements with economic incentives for choosing new high-efficiency natural gas water heaters and, additionally, Energy Star[®] rated furnaces. The Company will fund the Proposed Rebate Program, as they are funding the Existing Rebate Program, and will not use any ratepayer subsidies.

Staff submitted Data Requests to the Company for information about the Existing Rebate Program concerning participation, cost, and the potential impact on system capacity. Because the Existing Rebate Program had not been previously available, the Company could only estimate the extent of these effects. Consequently, Staff recommended and the Commission approved tariff sheets for the Existing Program to be an experimental program. Similarly, the Company has filed tariff sheets for the Proposed Rebate Program to be an experimental program.

Staff and the Company have been working on program implementation and tariff language prior to tariffs and documentation on the program being filed. Staff recognizes the unique situation of SMNG not having any jurisdictional electric providers in its service area; and has supported implementation of this program in the interest of SMNG's customers. The tariff sheets for the Proposed Rebate Program were filed on April 12, 2006 and substituted on April 26, 2006, and April 28, 2006, to correct typographical errors.

The individual rebate amounts for residential and commercial customers are: \$100 for replacing an existing electric water heater with a new natural gas water heater, \$40 for replacing an existing gas water heater with a new natural gas water heater, and \$250 for replacing an existing furnace with an Energy Star® rated natural gas furnace. Rebate amounts for builders, developers, and sub-contractors are: \$150 for installing a new natural gas water heater in any newly constructed or renovated building, and \$250 for installing a new Energy Star® rated natural gas furnace in any newly constructed or renovated building. Additionally, the Company plans to contract with certain appliance stores in the Company's service area to provide point-of-purchase rebates on natural gas water heaters and Energy Star® rated natural gas furnaces. The Rebate Program is voluntary and available to any participant. The participant should receive the rebate after submitting a properly completed application form. Sample rebate forms are attached. The Staff and the Company are in the process of finalizing details of the language and the availability of the form for the Proposed Rebate Program. The proposed tariff sheets bear an effective date of May 12, 2006, and the Proposed Rebate Program will conclude December 31, 2008 unless renewed by the Company.

When the existing tariff for the Existing Rebate Program was approved, the Commission granted SMNG a waiver of the Commission's Promotional Practices Rule. Based on the fact that there are no regulated electric companies operating in this area, Staff recommends that this waiver should continue to apply to the Proposed Rebate Program. The Staff has verified that the Company has filed its annual report and is not delinquent on any assessment. Staff has reviewed this filing and is not aware of any issue currently pending before the Commission that affects, or is affected by, this filing.

Staff therefore recommends approval of the following tariff sheets, as filed on April 12, 2006, and substituted on April 28, 2006, with an effective date of May 12, 2006:

Southern Missouri Natural Gas Company's Natural Gas Water Heater Rebate Program Description of Program and Application Form

In an effort to help with the initial cost of purchasing a new energy efficient *Natural Gas* water heater, Southern Missouri Natural Gas Co. (SMNG) the following **Rebate Programs** for both existing natural gas customers and new customers.

The participating customer (participant) in the rebate program must meet the following requirements:

- 1. The participant must show SMNG personnel a receipt no older than six months for the purchase of a new natural gas fired water heater.
- 2. The participant must allow SMNG personnel to inspect the new installation to insure that the installation meets applicable building codes.
- 3. If replacing an electric water heater, the participant must offer proof that an electric water heater has been replaced (keep the old water heater until the inspection is complete).
- **4.** The participant must obtain the signature of the SMNG inspector on the appropriate line below and the SMNG inspector must complete the information on installation and verification on this form.
- 5. This form, signed by the participant and the SMNG inspector, and accompanied with the above listed requirements must be presented at the SMNG office (can be mailed).

Electric Water Heater Replacement

For replacing an existing electric water heater with a new **Natural Gas** water heater, SMNG will rebate the participant \$100 (one hundred dollars) credit on their gas bill. This credit will be applied to the first appropriate charges due on participant's account.
