ORDER CANCELING PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND DIRECTING FILING

On June 2, 2006, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a request to cancel the prehearing conference set for June 5, 2006. Staff indicated in its filing that it was in settlement negotiations with Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, and that the parties did not believe a prehearing conference was necessary.
