**NOTICE REGARDING APPEARANCE PRO HAC VICE**

Issue Date: April 20, 2006

On April 19, 2006, David A. McCormick, a member of the Pennsylvania and District of Columbia Bars, but not a member of the Missouri Bar, filed a request to intervene on behalf of the Department of Defense and Other Federal Executive Agencies. The request to intervene was accompanied by a Statement of Visiting Attorney on Admissions to Practice and Entry of Appearance. That statement designates a member of the Missouri Bar, Jeffrey H. Rohrer, as local counsel.

Missouri Supreme Court Rule 6.01(m) provides that any non-Missouri attorney wishing to appear in a particular case in any court or administrative tribunal in this state must first pay a fee of \$100 to the Clerk of the Supreme Court for each case in which he or she seeks to appear. The rule further provides that any request to appear in any court or

administrative tribunal in this state must be accompanied by a receipt indicating that the \$100 fee has been paid (Rule 9.03).

Mr. McCormick has not complied with the Supreme Court's rules and the Commission cannot permit him to appear in this case until he complies with those rules.
