**NOTICE OF DISMISSAL AND NOTICE CLOSING CASE**

Issue Date: October 18, 2006

On September 22, 2006, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a complaint against The Empire District Gas Company. Staff complained that Empire had not submitted its gas supply and hedging plan to Staff as required under a Stipulation in Case No. GO-2006-0205. On October 13, Staff filed a Notice of Satisfaction and Dismissal of Complaint stating that Empire has submitted its plan as required by the Stipulation.

Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.116 allows a complainant to voluntarily dismiss its complaint, without an order from the Commission, if no testimony has been filed or oral evidence taken. There has been no testimony filed in this matter, nor oral evidence taken. Staff may therefore voluntarily dismiss its complaint.

The Commission also notes that Pittsburgh Corning Corporation requested to intervene in this matter. The Commission need not rule on Pittsburgh Corning's request as it is now moot.

There remains no further Commission action in this matter. Therefore, this case may be closed.
