MOTION FOR LEAVE TO LATE FILE TESTIMONY

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and moves the Commission for leave to late file the prefiled surrebuttal testimony of its primary witness John A. Rogers on the ground that he is presently unavailable to finalize that testimony at this time due to the death of his wife on Monday, May 7, 2012. Presently the evidentiary hearing in this case is scheduled for May 29 through June 1, but the Office of the Public Counsel filed a pleading on April 20, 2012, in which it related, "In March, the undersigned [(Lewis R. Mills, Jr., Public Counsel)] accepted an invitation to speak at a National Governors' Association meeting on energy policy in Washington D.C. being held on May 30 and 31. Accordingly, Public Counsel will be requesting a change in the currently-scheduled hearing dates." While Public Counsel has not yet filed that motion, he has suggested to the parties moving the hearing to June 11-14, and Staff has seen no objection to that suggestion. Staff expects to prefile the surrebuttal testimony of John A. Rogers shortly after he returns to work, perhaps as early as late next week.

WHEREFORE, Staff moves the Commission for leave to late file the surrebuttal testimony of its primary witness John A. Rogers.
