NOTICE ACKNOWLEDGING DISMISSAL OF COMPLAINT

Issue Date: March 27, 2007

On November 30, 2006, Mary Keaton filed a complaint against Laclede Gas Company. Laclede filed its answer on January 3, 2007, and the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed its report on January 10, 2007.

On March 13, 2007, prior to the filing of any testimony or the admission of any evidence, Ms. Keaton filed a Notice of Dismissal stating that all disputes between the parties have been resolved and that all parties of record had been served with a copy of their notice.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(1) permits a complainant to voluntarily dismiss its complaint without an order of the Commission at any time before prepared testimony has been filed or oral evidence has been offered.
