ORDER SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On February 13, 2007, Naomi Miller filed a complaint against Laclede Gas Company, claiming that Laclede Gas Company has overbilled her for roughly the last year. Laclede denies her allegations.

Staff filed a report on April 27 that stated that Ms. Miller is responsible for the disputed bills, and recommends that the complaint be dismissed. Ms. Miller responded on June 18, again asserting that she does not owe the disputed amounts.

The Commission finds that a prehearing conference is now appropriate. The parties or their representatives shall appear in person, or by telephone, at the conference. They should be prepared to discuss the nature of any discovery each will conduct, the time necessary to complete discovery, and to prepare for hearing. The parties should also be prepared to name the witnesses each expects to call at hearing; the number and nature of any exhibits each expects to offer at hearing; and the anticipated length of the hearing.

Also, the parties should be prepared to discuss the stipulation of facts not at issue. The parties will also be encouraged to discuss settlement.

If the parties do not resolve their dispute, they shall jointly prepare and file a proposed procedural schedule.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. A prehearing conference shall be held on July 9, 2007, beginning at 10:00 a.m., in Room 305 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This meeting will be held in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. 2. Any party wishing to appear by telephone shall notify the Regulatory Law Judge by calling 573-751-7497 no later than 5:00 p.m., June 29, 2007.
3. The parties shall jointly prepare and file a proposed procedural schedule no later than July 16, 2007.
4. This order shall become effective on June 20, 2007.
