ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT WITH PREJUDICE

Issue Date: June 10, 2008

Effective Date: June 20, 2008

The Commission convened an evidentiary hearing in this matter on April 29, 2008, at which time the parties made their entries of appearance. After being placed under oath, the complainant, Ms. Linda Light, acknowledged that her gas bill had recently been fully rectified by Missouri Gas Energy, and stated that she was now willing to voluntarily dismiss her formal complaint against the company with prejudice.¹

Given these circumstances, Ms. Light's complaint will be dismissed with prejudice pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(4), which states that a "case may be dismissed for good cause found by the commission after a minimum of ten (10) days notice to all parties involved."
