## ORDER DIRECTING MISSOURI PIPELINE COMPANY AND MISSOURI GAS COMPANY TO REVIEW TESTIMONY FOR APPROPRIATE CLASSIFICATION

Issue Date: November 21, 2006 Effective Date: November 21, 2006

On November 17, 2006, the Commission's Staff filed a pleading indicating that it has filed the surrebuttal testimony of its witness, Robert Schallenberg, as highly confidential in its entirety. Staff asks the Commission to order Missouri Pipeline Company and Missouri Gas Company to file a pleading by November 27, indicting what portion of that testimony should be released as public information and what should properly be classified as highly confidential or proprietary.

The information in Schallenberg's testimony has been designated as highly confidential by Missouri Pipeline and Missouri Gas. Paragraph I of the protective order that was issued in this case on June 22 requires the party asserting that information contained in testimony should be protected from disclosure to file a pleading within five days of the

filing of the testimony explaining the nature of the information sought to be protected and specifically stating the alleged harm resulting from disclosure of the information.

Because of the Thanksgiving Holiday, five working days after the testimony was filed on November 17 would be November 28. Missouri Pipeline and Missouri Gas will be ordered to file the pleading required by the Protective Order no later than that date.

## IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. No later than November 28, 2006, Missouri Pipeline Company, LLC, and Missouri Gas Company, LLC, shall file a pleading indicating what portion of the surrebuttal testimony filed by Robert Schallenberg should be released as public information and what portion should properly be classified as highly confidential or proprietary, In addition, Missouri Pipeline Company, LLC, and Missouri Gas Company, LLC, shall explain the nature of the information sought to be protected and specifically state the alleged harm that would result from disclosure of the information.
  - 2. This order shall become effective on November 21, 2006.
