On June 21, 2006, the Staff of the Commission filed a complaint against Missouri Pipeline Company, LLC, and Missouri Gas Company, LLC. Along with its complaint, Staff filed a Motion for Protective Order.

Staff explains that its investigation relating to this complaint concerns highly confidential and proprietary information that must be protected from disclosure to the public. Staff requests that the Commission issue its standard protective order to protect that information from inappropriate disclosure.

After reviewing Staff's motion, the Commission finds that there is a need to protect confidential information and that the request for a protective order is reasonable.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The protective order attached to this order (Attachment A) is adopted.

2. This order shall become effective on June 22, 2006.
