ORDER SETTING EVIDENTIARY HEARING

Unable to settle this dispute, Marlyn Young requests an evidentiary hearing, which the Missouri Public Service Commission will set. Because of the limited amount of testimony expected, it will not be necessary for the parties to file testimony prior to the hearing.

Because Complainant is representing himself, he will be allowed to first give a statement of his complaint. His statement will also serve as an opening statement. Questions directed toward Complainant will proceed as follows: the Commissioners and Judge; Staff; then, Laclede Gas Company. Complainant will then be allowed to respond to any subjects raised by those questions directed toward him. Thereafter, Staff will present its evidence. Questions of Staff will proceed as follows: the Commissioners and Judge; Laclede; Complainant; then, redirect by Staff. Finally, Laclede will present its evidence with questions in the following order: the Commissioners and Judge; Staff; Complainant; then,

Laclede's redirect. The parties will not be required to file post-hearing briefs but will instead give closing arguments.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. An evidentiary hearing shall be held on September 20, 2007, beginning at 10:00 a.m., in Room 310 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This hearing will be held in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. 2. This order shall become effective on August 30, 2007.
