The motion indicates that Ms. Tatro is a member in good standing of the bar of the State of Kansas, the United States District Court for the District of Kansas, and the United States Court of Appeals for the Tenth Circuit, and is qualified to appear in the

corresponding state and federal courts. The motion further states that Ms. Tatro is employed as an Associate General Counsel by Ameren Services Company, which has offices in Missouri, and that neither she nor any other member of the legal department of Ameren Services Company are disqualified to appear in any courts in which she is authorized to appear. Finally, the motion indicates that Mr. Byrne has designated Ms. Tatro to serve as associate counsel for purposes of this case.

Ms. Tatro has also submitted a September 12, 2007 letter from the Clerk of the Missouri Supreme Court showing Ms. Tatro's compliance with Missouri Supreme Court Rule 6.01(m) with regard to this case.

The Commission finds that Ms. Tatro has complied with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.040(3)(C) and Missouri Supreme Court Rule 6.01(m). Accordingly, her motion for leave to appear and participate in this case on behalf of AmerenUE as a visiting attorney is granted.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Wendy K. Tatro's motion for leave to appear and participate in Case No. GC-2007-0442 as a visiting attorney under Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.040(3)(C) is granted.
