## ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On May 29, 2007, Doris House filed a complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission against Laclede Gas Company (Laclede). Laclede filed its answer to the complaint on July 5, 2007, and the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed its Report on July 31, 2007. On September 4, 2007, Ms. House filed a response addressing the statements contained in Laclede Gas Company's answer and Staff's report.

On September 20, 2007, a prehearing conference was held in this case. Parties participating in the prehearing included Ms. House, Laclede, and the Commission's Staff. The Office of the Public Counsel did not participate in the prehearing conference.

On September 19, 2007, Staff filed a motion requesting until November 2, 2007, to file a proposed procedural schedule in this case. The procedural schedule is currently due on September 28. In support of its request, Staff states that the parties participating in the

discovery conference determined that more time is required to evaluate information and to conduct further discussions. The request for extension of time is reasonable and shall be granted.

- 1. The parties shall have until November 2, 2007 to file a proposed procedural schedule in this case.
