ORDER ADOPTING REVISED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

The Commission initially adopted a procedural schedule for this case on April 12, 2006. That schedule led to an evidentiary hearing on September 20 and 21. On June 21, the Commission granted an unopposed motion that extended the filing date for direct testimony until July 14. Since the parties indicated that the revised filing date would likely necessitate further changes to the schedule, the Commission ordered the parties to file a revised procedural schedule by July 3.

On July 3, the Commission's Staff, acting on behalf of the Office of the Public Counsel, and Laclede Gas Company, filed a revised proposed procedural schedule. Staff did not purport to act on behalf of the United Steelworkers of America, Local No. 11-6, AFL-CIO, because Staff was unable to contact Local 11-6 to obtain final approval of the pleading. However, Staff indicates its belief that the proposed schedule is acceptable to

Local 11-6. Local 11-6 did not file a proposed procedural schedule of its own by July 3 as required by the Commission's order.

No party has objected to the revised proposed procedural schedule filed by Staff and no competing proposed procedural schedule has been filed. The Commission will adopt the schedule proposed in Staff's motion.
