**ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE AND SETTING DATE FOR SUBMISSION**

On June 21, 2006, the Staff of the Public Service Commission filed a complaint against Missouri Pipeline Company, LLC, and Missouri Gas Company, LLC. Staff's complaint alleges that the respondents have violated their tariffs regarding the provision of transportation services. Staff asks for authority to seek civil penalties for the alleged violations and overcharges. The respondents have been ordered to answer Staff's complaint by July 22.

Staff's new complaint is related to an on-going complaint that is pending in Case No. GC-2006-0378. The Commission will provide notice of the filing of the new complaint to the parties to Case No. GC-2006-0378. A date for intervention of proper parties will also be set.
