ORDER RESETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND DIRECTING THE PARTIES TO STIPULATE TO FACTS NOT IN DISPUTE

On February 20, 2007,¹ the Commission set a prehearing conference in this matter for March 5. On February 28, Laclede Gas Company ("Laclede") requested the date be reset for March 13 or 15 due to scheduling conflicts. - 1. The prehearing conference scheduled for March 5, 2007 is canceled.
- 2. The parties shall appear at a prehearing conference to be held on March 15, 2007, beginning at 10:00 a.m. The prehearing conference will be held in Room 305 at the Commission's offices in the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri, a building that meets the accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. - 3. No later than March 14, 2007, the parties shall jointly file a stipulation as to all material facts not in dispute in this matter.
