The Commission is issuing this notice regarding procedures to be followed at the evidentiary hearing, which is scheduled to begin on November 29, 2021. The Commission intends to conduct this hearing in person, but appropriate measures will be in place to maintain social distancing to the extent possible. Physical attendance in the hearing room should be reserved as much as possible for persons essential to the hearing (the bench, court reporter, attorneys, and the witness testifying, or preparing to testify). Hearing Room 305 and Conference Room 110 in the Governor Office Building have been reserved as hearing watch spaces. Those rooms will be connected to the livestream from the hearing room. Counsel should have digital copies of non-prefiled exhibits available to e-mail to opposing counsel.
