ORDER GRANTING APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE

Evergy Metro, Inc. d/b/a Evergy Missouri Metro submitted tariff sheets on January 7, 2022, to produce a net increase in its electric base rates. The Commission provided notice of Evergy Missouri Metro's application and set a deadline for applications to intervene.

On February 10, 2022, Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers (MIEC) timely filed an application to intervene. MIEC stated that it is a non-profit corporation that represents the interest of industrial customers in matters involving utility issues. MIEC stated its interests are different than those of the general public. MIEC stated that it has not yet taken a position on Evergy Missouri Metro's application.

On February 11, 2022, Google LLC timely filed an application to intervene. Google stated that it is a limited liability corporation and has an interest in potentially developing data center facilities. Google stated its interests are different than those of the general public. Google further stated that granting its intervention request would serve the public interest. Google stated that it has not yet taken a position on Evergy Missouri Metro's application.

More than ten days have passed since the filing of MIEC's and Google's respective applications to intervene and no one has responded.¹ After considering the unopposed applications to intervene, the Commission finds that MIEC and Google have interests which are different from that of the general public and allowing them to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.075(3), the Commission will grant the applications to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The application to intervene of MIEC is granted.
2. The application to intervene of Google is granted.
3. This order shall be effective when issued.
